Notes for Teachers

- 1. Closing date for school entries is June 9th 2014.
- 2. Each child can enter only one poem. All poems must be in English and the entrants own work, with strictly no parental help in the writing of the poem.
- 3. Each poem should have a title and be on a separate piece of A4. No pupil/school names on front.
- 4. School stamp and name of child on back of each poem sheet.
- 5. One completed entry form per school: 30 poems maximum per school.
- 6. Poems preferably handwritten but typed acceptable for Years 7 (i.e. ages 11-12 years).
- 7. Entrants must be 8-12 on the closing date June 9th 2014.
- 8. Young poets can enter poems already written this school year at home or school or write new poems on any theme.

Prizes: awarded within each year group, with special Chiswick Book Festival Young People's Poetry Competition 2014 Certificates
