Notes for Teachers

1. Closing date for school entries is June 9th 2014.
2. Each child can enter only one poem. All poems must be in English and the entrants own work, with strictly no parental help in the writing of the poem.
3. Each poem should have a title and be on a separate piece of A4. No pupil/school names on front.
4. School stamp and name of child on back of each poem sheet.
5. One completed entry form per school: 30 poems maximum per school.
6. Poems preferably handwritten but typed acceptable for Years 7 (i.e. ages 11-12 years).
7. Entrants must be 8-12 on the closing date June 9th 2014.
8. Young poets can enter poems already written this school year at home or school or write new poems on any theme.

Prizes : awarded within each year group , with special Chiswick Book Festival Young People's Poetry Competition 2014 Certificates
