Notes for Teachers

1. Closing date for school entries is June 6th 2016.
2. Each child can enter only one poem. Strictly only the child's work with no parental help in the writing of the poem.
3. Each poem should be on a separate piece of A4. No pupil/school names on front.
4. School stamp and name of child on back of each poem sheet.
5. One completed entry form per school: 30 poems maximum per school.
6. Poems preferably handwritten but typed acceptable for Years 7.
7. Entrants must be 8-12 on the closing date June 6th 2016.
8. Young poets can enter poems already written this school year at home or school or write new poems on any theme.

Prize-giving: Five prizes (one for each year group) will be presented at The Chiswick Book Festival after the special morning events for children on Saturday 17th September 2016. Exact time to be confirmed.
