Notes for Teachers

- 1. Closing date for school entries is Monday June 4th 2018.
- 2. Each child can enter only one poem.
- 3. Each poem should be on a separate piece of A4. No pupil/school names on front.
- 4. School stamp and name of child on back of each poem sheet.
- 5. One completed entry form per school: 30 poems maximum per school.
- 6. Poems preferably handwritten but typed acceptable for Years 6-7 and in special circumstance.
- 7. Entrants must be 8-12 on the closing date June 4th 2018.
- 8. Young poets can enter poems already written this school year at home or school or write new poems on any theme.
- 9. New request: Please send one set of originals as usual and <u>also one</u> set of photo-copied entry form and photo-copied poems (with no names)for the judging stage.

Prize-giving: Five prizes (one for each year group) will be presented at The Chiswick Book Festival at the weekend - probably on Saturday 15th September 2018. Exact time to be confirmed in the late summer.
